All fees to be paid in advance of permit being issued. It is understood that any permit issued on this application will not grant any right of privilege to perform any electrical work that is not in conformance with the County of Monroe Electrical Ordinance, Codes and Regulations. The applicant further agrees to notify the Monroe County Zoning Office at the appropriate stages during the work to be performed to arrange for inspections.

Permits shall be issued to licensed electrical contractors or a homeowner; provided the homeowner personally performs the electrical work and provided that the electrical work is to be installed in the home occupied by the homeowner and that the home is a single family residence or owner occupied duplex. The permit will be issued to a homeowner with the stipulation that you own the home and will live in the home for a period of not less than two (2) years.

If the Electrical Inspector has issued a "notice of Non-Compliance" listing defect/violations requiring corrective action and subsequently re-inspects the job an additional fee of \$65.00 shall be assessed for additional inspection.

Any person violating any provision shall be fined in the amount of not more than \$750.00. Each day such a violation is committed or permitted to continue shall constitute a separate offense.
