Pursuant to 730 ILCS 110/15(2)(a), each county in the 24<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit shall have its own Probation Services Department, under the authority of the Chief Judge of said Circuit. Each county's Probation Services Department shall consist of one Chief Managing Officer, as well as any Probation Officers and support staff that the Chief Judge deems necessary from time to time.

Each county shall be responsible for all salaries and other expenses, including but not limited to those set forth in 730 ILCS 110/15(11), incurred in the operation of its Probation Services Department, subject to reimbursement in accordance with 730 ILCS 110/15 and 730 ILCS 110/16 by the Division of Probation Services of the Illinois Supreme Court.
