

Pursuant 705 ILCS 35/2f-12(f) and Illinois Supreme Court Rule 21(e), all cases that were filed in Perry County, Illinois, prior to December 5, 2022, and are pending as of December 5, 2022, shall become a pending case in Perry County, in the 24<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit. All cases that were filed in Monroe County, Illinois, prior to December 5, 2022, and are pending as of December 5, 2022, shall become a pending case in Monroe County, in the 24<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit. All cases that were filed in Randolph County, Illinois, prior to December 5, 2022, and are pending as of December 5, 2022, shall become a pending case in Randolph County, in the 24<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit. All cases that were filed in Washington County, Illinois, prior to December 5, 2022, and are pending as of December 5, 2022, shall become a pending case in Washington County, in the 24<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit.

Any pleading filed in any case in Perry, Monroe, Randolph, or Washington Counties on or after December 5, 2022, shall indicate in the pleading caption that said pleading is being filed in the Circuit Court of the 24<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit, in the respective County. If the pleading does not indicate so, or indicates that the pleading is being filed in the 20<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit, the Circuit Clerk of the respective County shall not accept the pleading until modified to comply with the foregoing.
