
**IN RE: MARRIAGE FUNDS OF THE) GENERAL
 COUNTIES OF THE 24th JUDICIAL) ADMINISTRATIVE
 CIRCUIT AND FEE AMOUNT) ORDER. 22-24**

Pursuant to Illinois Supreme Court Rule 40, all marriage solemnizations and civil union certifications performed by any judicial officer shall be at times and places as directed by the Resident Circuit Judge of the county of the 24th Judicial Circuit in which the ceremony is to occur.

The Circuit Clerk of each county shall collect a fee of \$10 for each marriage solemnization or civil union certification performed by a judicial officer in that county. No additional fee or gratuity will be solicited or accepted.

Any fee received shall be deposited in a federally insured or fully collateralized bank account in the name of the "Marriage and Civil Union Fund of the Circuit Court of _____ County" and may be spent in furtherance of the administration of justice for items specified in Illinois Supreme Court Rule 40(c).
