MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
OF MONROE COUNTY, ILLINOIS MAY 5, 2025

The meeting of the County Commissioners of Monroe County, Illinois was called to order at 8:15 a.m. by Chairman George E. Green.

The meeting opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Chairman George E. Green, Commissioner Vicki Koerber and Commissioner Doug Garmer were present.

Others present included County Clerk Jonathan McLean, County Engineer Aaron Metzger, Pat Kelly, Jim Crowe, State's Attorney Ryan Webb, Scott Woodsmall from the Republic Times, and Sheila Wetzler.

Commissioner Koerber made a motion to approve the Board meeting minutes held on April 21, 2025. Second by Commissioner Garmer. All voting Aye. None Nay. None Absent. Motion carried.

Chairman Green presented certificates honoring George Gregson, for 24 years of service, and Ed Breeding, for 18 years of service, as Road District Commissioners. Both will be retiring on May 19, 2025.

Chairman Green asked for public comments. There were none.

Commissioner Koerber made a motion to approve the consent agenda. The following items were on the consent agenda:

Mr. Metzger noted that construction on the Bluff Road bridge over Carr Creek will start on May 12, 2025.

Chairman Green recognized the Waterloo Country Club for their 100-year anniversary.

Jesica Gentry Schlimme with the Monroe Randolph Transit District presented an annual ridership report. A copy of the report was filed for record with the County Clerk.

Commissioner Koerber made a motion to approve going into closed session for the purpose of litigation and for the purchase, sale, or lease of real estate. Second by Commissioner Garmer. All voting Aye. None Nay. None Absent. Motion carried. Resolution #25-31


