Re: Downtown Resurfacing Project

The City of Waterloo is scheduled to resurface the roads in the downtown area during a 2-3 week span (weather permitting), sometime between June 21 and July 26, 2023. This date range was chosen to avoid having roadwork during community events as much as possible. The contractor will give us an exact start date in early June, and you will receive follow-up communication as soon as that information is available.

As part of the program, the following streets will be milled and resurfaced:

Main Street (from Fourth Street to the alleyway north of the old firehouse)

Church Street (from Fourth Street to First Street)

Third Street (from Market to Church Street)

Mill Street (from Market to South Library Street)

First Street (from Market to Church Street)

A map is included as well.

Although there will be minor traffic delays and parking limitations, the work will be completed in phases in an effort to allow some available parking in the downtown area throughout the process. Please watch for the temporary “no parking” signs that will be posted as needed during construction.

Thank you in advance for your patience and cooperation as we work to improve our beautiful city.
