MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
OF MONROE COUNTY, ILLINOIS NOVEMBER 9, 2021

The meeting of the County Commissioners of Monroe County, Illinois was called to order at 8:15 a.m. by Vice Chairman Dennis Knobloch.
